 - Who am I?
 - Natural/physical features of my town
 - Social and cultural information about my community
 - Economic activity and structure in the community
 - Political activity and structure in the community
 - My picture of the evolution of my town
- These records will be used in your evaluation so take your time and put forth your best effort.

NORTH COUNTRY HISTORY AND GEOGRAPHY

- Follow these steps to complete the program. The result will be a clear and detailed picture of your town and how you fit into it.
 - Research and record your ancestry in the “Who am I” folder
 - Research and record information in the “natural and physical features” of my town folder.
 - Research and record information in the “social and cultural characteristics” folder for the people in your town up to 1836.
 - Research and record information in the “economic activity” folder for your town up to 1836.
 - Research and record information in the “political activity” folder for your town up to 1836.
 - Using any media you want, put together a picture of your town that represents its founding up to 1836. Share with your classmates and make changes if needed.
 - Select topics that are of interest or ones that need more research based on your findings.
